


ECHO is the largest provider of innovative day opportunities for people with learning and other disabilities in Herefordshire.

We are an Arts and Crafts project with a focus on upcycling and producing high-quality items to sell in the ECHO shop and other outlets in the community.

We rely largely on public donations of wool, fabric, haberdashery and art and craft materials. These are then upcycled within the project or sent to the ECHO shop to be sold.

Clever Betsy endeavours to reflect the ECHO guiding principles of Participant Choice, Participant Support, Community Access, Participant Involvement, Quality and Collaboration.

In addition, we aim to provide our participants with a safe and calm environment in which to learn new skills, make lasting friendships and above all have fun.
